b: Resurfacing of Asbell Street in Irwinton: The City of Irwinton is resurfacing Asbell Street there is .062 miles that belong to the county the cost to resurface this portion would be approximately \$6200.00 it is the suggestion of the County Manager that we resurface this portion so that all of Asbell would be resurfaced to Hwy 441. Motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Hagins to have the counties portion resurfaced.
