The Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners met in a Work Session at 4:00 PM on January 17, 2017 at their office in the Courthouse. The following Commissioners were present: Chairman Mark DuPree, Commissioner C. L Brooks, Commissioner J. M. Howell, and Commissioner John Williams.

The following staff was present: County Manager David Franks, Interim County Manager Joseph Mosley.

Visitors: Wil Stafford and Bob Brown with BTBB Architects, Elections Superintendent Tracy Strange, Jonathan Jackson, Frank Walls, Jonathan Snow, Bryan Sappe, G. W. Young, Bobby Greene, and Angie King from the Development Authority, Sheriff Richard Chatman, and Marty Dominy.

Chairman DuPree opened the Meeting and asked Will Stafford to address the Board on the upcoming projects. Will came forward and gave an overview of the new security entrance for the Wilkinson County Courthouse. He answered questions from the various commissioners. Will stated the cost would be around \$350,000. Sheriff Chatman provided his opinion when asked.

Will also advised the Board that he had been asked to address a roof leak in the main courtroom. Chairman DuPree asked Will if he could make the leak a stand alone project and attend to it first.

The last project discussed was the Development Authority / Chamber building. Will showed the Board the current plan and stated the cost would be between \$280,000 and \$300,000.

Chairman DuPree asked Mr. Franks to update the board on SPLOST funds available for the projects. Mr. Franks stated that at this point the SPLOST County balance was around \$600,000 and that we would be receiving a Motor Grader in March that would cost a little over \$200,000 also there were two pickups coming that would cost around \$55,000. This would probably leave a balance of around \$345,000.

Chairman Dupree adjourned the meeting.
