WORK SESSION
APRIL 8, 2014
9:30 AM

The Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners met in a Work Session at 9:30 AM on April 8, 2014 at their office in the Courthouse. The following Commissioners were present: Chairman Dennis Holder, Commissioner J.M. Howell, and Commissioner C.L. Brooks, Commissioner John Williams, and Commissioner James Hagins.

The following staff was present: County Manager David Franks and County Attorney.

Visitors: Josh Waller Georgia DOT, Barry Wood Georgia DOT, Representative Bubber Epps, Development Authority Chairman Frank Wall, Development Authority Director Jonathan Jackson.

Chairman Holder opened the Meeting by explaining the state of disrepair Wriley Road was in due to trucking. He turned the conversation over to County Attorney DuBose Porter; Mr. Porter stated that he had been asked to come up with the possibilities of what needed to be done to repair the road. In his opinion the possibilities were to get State aid through Economic Development, bring litigation on Carbo Industries, or Wilkinson County fund the project. A combination of any of the three would also be a possibility. At that point he asked Representative about the request for assistance that had been sent to the State. Representative Epps stated that he was not sure that Senator Lucas had actually asked for the assistance. County Manager David Franks addressed the group to explain what the problem was. He stated that a C & D Landfill had been opened 4 miles up Wriley Road from where Dent Road runs into Wriley Road and that Arcilla was hauling for Carbo Industries. Although State Law dictates that a pickup and delivery allows State weights on County Maintained Roads, the number of hauls was obliterating the road. At that point Josh Waller explained that the only revenue that he knew of was LMIG and that we would need to make a formal request. Barry Wood explained the process for the request. Chairman Holder asked Mr. Franks to make the formal request.

Chairman Holder adjourned the meeting.
