The Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners met in a Called Session at 11:00 AM on June 24, 2014 at their office in the Courthouse. The following Commissioners were present: Chairman Dennis Holder, Commissioner C.L. Brooks, Commissioner James Hagins, and Commissioner John Williams.

A: Chairman Holder opened the meeting by explaining to the Board that an event had been scheduled at the Gordon Complex which would help raise funds for a group that is trying to unseat the current Mayor of Gordon, Mayor Whipple-Lue. He asked Recreation Director Dennis Moore what criteria he had for renting the facility. Mr. Moore stated that the Recreation Authority had a Facility Guideline that he went by when renting request came up. He also stated that there weren't many request and that although he did not feel as though the reason for rental were a good idea, that the group did meet the guidelines he currently used. He also stated that the group had agreed to pay the fees that the guidelines required. Mr. Franks gave Commissioner Williams a copy of the guidelines.

Mr. Chatman asked Mr. Moore if he would rent the facility to a member of a group in

favor of the Mayor, at which point Mr. Moore said yes. Mr. Franks stated that in his opinion the Facility Guidelines needed to be looked at by the Recreation Authority and that he would be glad to ask the Regional Commission to assist and the any legal questions could be answered by the County Attorney. Mr. Chatman stated that he thought that would be a good idea.

Mr. Chatman asked if the Board was going to let the event proceed, and the members agreed that the group had followed the current guidelines.
