WORK SESSION  
OCTOBER 8, 2013  
10:00 AM

The Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners met in a Work Session at 10:00 AM on October 8, 2013 at their office in the Courthouse. The following Commissioners were present: Chairman Dennis Holder, Commissioner J.M. Howell, Commissioner C.L. Brooks, Commissioner James Hagins, and Commissioner John Williams.

The following staff was present: County Manager David Franks and County Attorney Dubose Porter.

Visitors: State Representative Bubber Epps.

Chairman Holder opened the Meeting by asking County Manager David Franks to go over the resurfacing list with the Board. Mr. Franks explained to the Board that he had added the district to the resurfacing list as requested. Each Commissioner looked over the list and made recommendations for their District. They are as follows:

- Jackson Road from the railroad tracks to Ivey Farm Road.
- Claymont Road from Hwy 57 to Gordon McIntyre Road.
- J.R. Simms Road starting at a point approximately one mile from Hwy 96 to the first bridge.
- Old Balls Ferry Road from Hwy 112 to Little Sandy Creek Road.
- Quinn Williams Road from Hwy 112 to Stuckey Road.
- Martin Luther King Road from Hwy 57 to Asbell Road.
- Council McCranie Road from 441 to a point of 1.3 miles on Council McCranie Road.
- Cross Justice Road from the bridge on Cross Justice Road to the end of the pavement.

Chairman Holder asked Mr. Franks to get prices for patching and resurfacing on the above roads.

Chairman Holder asked County Attorney DuBose Porter to advise the Board on O.C.G.A. 32-6-1. Mr. Porter explained to the Board that in his opinion this law would be a good tool for the County to use to have some roads that had been damaged by trucking repaired. He explained that in his opinion this law would require the culprit of the damage to repair the road. Chairman also asked Representative Epps to advise the Board

on O.C.G.A. 32-6-1, Rep. Epps explained to the Board that he agreed with Mr. Porter and felt that the County could also use the law as a tool to designate routes for trucking. Mr. Porter stated that his suggestion to repair Wriley Road would be to get an appointment with the DOT Commissioner and request emergency funds. Rep Epps suggested that Mr. Porter call Atlanta and set up the meeting. Commissioner Williams suggested that a Work Session be set up to advise Carbo of the code section O.C.G.A. 32-6-1.

Chairman Holder adjourned the meeting.
