WORK SESSION  
November 6, 2012  
9:30 AM

The Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners met in a Work Session at 10:00 AM on November 6, 2012 at their office in the Courthouse. The following Commissioners were present: Chairman Dennis Holder, Commissioner J.M. Howell, and Commissioner C.L. Brooks, Commissioner John Williams, and Commissioner James Hagins.

The following staff was present: County Manager David Franks.

Visitors: Marty Dominy, and Joe McKinzie.

Chairman Holder opened the Meeting by asking Tax Commissioner Vanessa Fountain to address the Board on ideas she has to collect past due taxes. Ms. Fountain told the Commissioners that she had thought about having a six month period of time where she could offer a reduction of the 10% penalty for payment of past due taxes. Commissioner Howell stated that he wasn't sure if that would be a good idea or not. He said that it might be better to just make that offer on older taxes. Chairman Holder asked what other Counties were doing. Ms. Fountain stated that she was not aware of any other County that had a similar situation to Wilkinson County, however she would be glad to ask. Chairman Holder asked Ms. Fountain gather some additional information and present it to the Board at a Work Session to be scheduled before the next meeting.

Chairman Holder asked County Manager David Franks to address the Board on the LMIG Program. Mr. Franks told the Commissioners that the new State assistance program was called LMIG. He stated that they could choose to pave an existing road or resurface an existing road. He presented estimates for Oochee Creek Road, Holloway Ray Road, and Brewer Road. He also presented the Commissioners with an updated resurfacing list. Mr. Franks stated that the funds had to have a 30% match and could be saved up to 3 years.

Commissioner Howell stated that Oochee Creek Road had been on the paving list for some time and that he would recommend that the funds be allocated to pave it. The Commissioners asked Mr. Franks to place it on the Agenda for the next meeting.

Chairman Holder adjourned the meeting.
